From Father's Desk...

A Time of Transition

Budgetary difficulties and personnel changes are thrusting us into a period of transition after a six year program specifically focused on areas of ongoing faith formation for adults and youth ministry. Our youth minister, Dave Dearden, will be moving on to other work after a five year process of building up a youth ministry program for the parish. I am deeply grateful to Dave for all that he has done: I have learned much from him and have come to know him as a man deeply devoted to Christ and the Church, and I believe that he has been a sower of valuable seeds of faith in many of the teenagers of Dartmouth, North and South. While very many Evangelical Protestant churches have a "youth pastor" ---someone with the specific skills to speak the Gospel to today's young people—we have been one of the few local Catholic parishes to have a "youth minister," (in our own terminology). I think that it behooves us to maintain something along these lines: Hence, with the aid of a committee composed of volunteers, parents, and teens, I have discerned it appropriate to hire Mr. Joe Martino to take over the role of youth minister. Regrettably, due to a strained budget, this position will not have the same dimensions it had with Dave, but we hope to maintain those elements which are essential in order to make our best attempt to keep our teens in relationship with Christ and his Church.

The ongoing formation of Adults, which has been expressed through multiple programs and groups within the parish, will also be undergoing significant changes because of budgetary stresses: Our Director of Adult Faith Formation, Paula Raposo, has been reduced to half-time, and she will now focus the lion's share of her time on the initiation of adults into the Church via RCIA, including the completion of initiation for those who never received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Paula will also maintain the parish website, which requires weekly updates and, in the absence of any candidates for RCIA, she will offer other programs that serve to enable adults to continue their formation as Christian Disciples. Over the past 5 years Paula has been a most valuable colleague to me, and I think that there are few who work as hard as she does to prepare, coordinate, and facilitate parish programming. I deeply regret the losses which come with her new schedule. The challenges of reconfiguring the ministries and programs of the parish into a sustainable model are not finished. Further alterations will be necessary in order to account for the deficit in yearly spending. As the "pastoral year" draws to a close, I will attempt to complete these changes with the aid of the Parish Finance Committee. Moreover, I am beginning the process of considering new programs to offer myself in areas of Faith and spirituality. These could include, but are not limited to, some of the following: History of the Church, Biblical Roots of the Mass, The Teachings of Pope Benedict on the Identity of Christ, What is the Nature of the Church?, Catholic Moral Questions, etc.
