Faith-filled Adults

What does God “look like” to you when you pray? This is a simplistic way of asking what image, picture, idea, or even temperament of God might come into your mind and heart as you pray. Often time prayer is a time we reach out to God with our thanks, requests, hopes, desires, problems or decisions. Each of us certainly knows where we are and what we want to communicate to God in our prayer. Think for a moment though about where and how you sense God’s presence during those moments of prayer? Where is God when you pray? What image do you hold of God during the time in which you reach out in prayer?

Recently I came across an image of God and the human person during the time of prayer when reading a book titled *Armchair Mystic* by Mark E Thibodeaux S.J. I thought I’d share it with you. The author used the example of an infant in a crib laying on its back arms and legs outstretched to represent the person in prayer. The infant reaches up, wanting to be picked up and held perhaps in glee, perhaps in distress or somewhere in-between. The child reaches and reaches but it is the action of the loving parent who reaches down to pick up and hold the infant that finally brings them together. Isn’t prayer like that? It is our desire to be held by God in good times and in times of distress and God’s loving response reaching out to us in our desire.

Bible Study

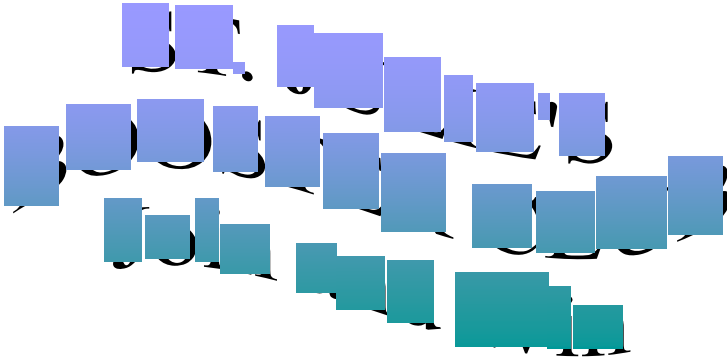
